Technology - In our studies of Technology this term 2.1 and 2.2 are constructing dioramas. The students are currently considering what their diorama might look like and what materials they will need.

The theme of the diorama will be a Christmas scene. We have asked students to collect any materials that will suit their dioramas that may be readily available. Please do not go out and buy anything, as broken Christmas trinkets, paper towel rolls, material scraps etc can be very useful for this activity.

We have also asked the students to bring in a shoe box or, ideally, an empty multipack potato chip box (the one with 20 single serves). We welcome any extra unused materials you may have that can be shared with others.
