This will be provided to each child (for group check-in) at the domestic terminal when we meet on the afternoon of Sunday 1 May.


Departure information: Parents are asked to have their child at Qantas Domestic Terminal Four (T4) by 2.00pm on Sunday 1 May. We will meet at the Qantas check-in area. We will then have sufficient time to finalise check-in and be ready to board our flight (QF718), which is scheduled to depart at 3.35pm.

What to bring: Students will be asked to bring their luggage in a suit case or sports bag that has clear identification on it. The weight limit for this luggage is 23 kg. A small carry-on bag is also allowed. The weight limit for this is 7kg. A copy of the clothing/requirements list is attached for your reference.

Arrival back in Perth: Parents are asked to be at the Qantas Domestic Terminal Four (T4) on Thursday 5 May prior to the scheduled arrival time of 9.30pm. We will meet you at the luggage carousel assigned to our flight (QF719). Please check the arrivals screens for this information. The children will only be allowed to leave the terminal if collected by a parent. If you are unable to be at the airport and would like to nominate an alternative person to collect your child this must be arranged prior to the study tour.

Parent meeting: A final parent meeting will occur on Thursday 28 April at 2.50pm. This will be held in the year 6 classroom. This will be an opportunity to share any additional information and have any questions answered. We look forward to seeing as many year 6 parents there as possible.
