I am pleased to provide you with the following details regarding our excursion to the Piney Lakes Environmental Education Centre on Wednesday 28 June 2017.

This excursion provides an opportunity for students to engage with learning opportunities regarding indigenous culture including the importance of the reserve from a historical point of view. Significant places, trees, plants and animals from the Noongar culture will be shared as will the links these have with the six seasons.

In addition, students will also participate in learning opportunities that explore the bushland during a guided tour and learn about plant communities, biodiversity, urban land use issues, altered habitats and general environmental awareness.

Students will leave from the school by bus at 0845 and travel to the Piney Lakes Environmental Education Centre in Winthrop. The learning experiences will conclude at 1345, and it is anticipated that the bus will return to school just before the siren.

Classroom teachers: Alyssa Marsh, Tim Tyrie and Rhiannon Naley will attend and supervise the students on the day.

Students will need to be in full school uniform including their school hat. Students will need to wear sunscreen and bring their lunch, snacks and a water bottle in a bag that they can carry with them throughout the day. We request that all items be clearly labelled and valuables such as mobile phones and cameras are left at home.
