I am pleased to provide you with the following details regarding our school musical being held at the Mandurah Performing Arts Centre (MPAC) on Thursday 19 November 2015.

This excursion has been planned to provide an opportunity for students to rehearse for our school production and participate in the performing arts. The presentation of our production of ***A Kidsummer Night's Dream*** (based on Shakespeare's *A Midsummer Night's Dream*) to a live audience will be performed on the same night as this dress rehearsal at MPAC. There will be a cost of \$5.00 for this excursion. This will cover bus travel to and from the venue (Mandurah Bus Charters).

Students attending the excursion: All students from Pre-primary to Year 6 will participate.

Students in years 3 -6 will travel to MPAC at 08:30am and leave at 2:15pm to return to school by the end of the day.

Students in years Pre-primary to 2 will travel to MPAC at 10:30am and leave at 1:30pm to return to school.

Members of the supervisory team are: School staff.

Special clothing or other items required: Students will need to be in full school uniform. Students will change in to their costumes at the venue and back in to uniform before returning to school. Students will need their school bags to take their lunch, snacks and water bottles with them.
