I am pleased to provide you with the following details regarding an upcoming incursion **West OZ Wildlife** on Tuesday May 10, 2016.

West Oz Wildlife has been conducting Educational Hands on wildlife displays around Perth for several years. West Oz Wildlife teaches students animal care and conservation through hands on experiences with a variety of Australian wildlife.

Students will engage in learning opportunities regarding native wildlife, animal care, safe animal handling and the ecosystems in which they live. The students will get the opportunity to get up close and personal with all of the wildlife, pat all animals, and hold the reptiles.

This incursion will support current learning in the classroom in the Science area focusing on Biological sciences. In this section of the curriculum students investigate living things, including animals and plants, and their interdependence and interactions within ecosystems. They explore their life cycles, body systems, structural adaptations and behaviours and how these features aid survival.
