

Canberra Study Tour - What to bring... what not to bring.

Items to bring

Suitcase or soft bag

Pyjamas - Warm

Bed socks

Underwear - at least 5 pairs

Socks - at least 5 pairs

Shoes - at least two pairs. Sneakers / enclosed shoes (**No heels, thongs, sandals**)

Full school uniform & school jumper – to be worn on tours to Parliament House and The War Memorial.

Jumper

Waterproof jacket / raincoat

Long pants - cargo pants / tracksuit

Hat, Canberra Tour Beanie (will be provided)

Optional Items - thermals / scarves / gloves.

Toiletries - Toothbrush & Toothpaste / Shampoo & Conditioner & Body Wash (travel size). Hair Brush.

NO MAKE-UP & NO HAIR STRAIGHTENERS

Hand Luggage

School bag / backpack— Will be worn everyday so comfortable back straps are required

Small pencil case (No textas)

Canberra scrapbook (provided)

Water bottle (empty for flight)

Travel tissues

Book

Optional book of puzzles (Find a Word, Brainteasers, Suduko etc)

Camera — responsibility of the children. Note: All children will be provided with a CD of photos following the Study Tour.

Pocket Money Guidelines

A limit of between \$40 - \$50 spending money had been set. We would like to keep the money safe as possible. The money is to be placed in an envelope/plastic money bag with the amount and student name on it. These will be collected by school staff prior to departure and will be provided to the child as needed.

Insurance

Travel insurance is not included in the travel arrangements. This must be organised by parents prior to departure.

Medication

All necessary medication needs to be clearly labelled and given to school staff at the airport. Please do not under any circumstances put Panadol or similar products into children's bags. All medication MUST have an accompanying Medical Action Plan, medication will not be accepted at the airport without a pre-completed plan.

Weather

Temperatures range from around 3 degrees to 15 degrees—please provide comfortable daytime and evening wear to accommodate the temperature range.

Mobile Phones

Students will **not** be able to take mobile phones on the Study Tour. If there are particular circumstances, staff will negotiate the use of the school phone to contact family. Parents will need to discuss such arrangements with supervising staff. You may also be contacted by a staff member if the need arises.

NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES - eg iPods, MP3 Players.
